Eileen Roche is considered an expert in the machine embroidery industry. Founder and editor of Designs in Machine Embroidery magazine, Eileen Roche has invented many products that embroiderers depend on to make machine embroidery more successful including the patented In The HoopTM Angle Finder, Snap-Hoop, Quick-Snap and Stipple! design collections. Eileen is also the author of eight books – all on machine embroidery. Eileen has appeared in dozens of PBS television shows: Sewing with Nancy, It's Sew Easy and Martha's Sewing Room and can be found on Craftsy in the Machine Embroidered Quilt and Machine Embroidered T-Shirt classes.

Marie Zinno is a regular contributor to Designs in Machine Embroidery and Stitches magazines and is a commercial embroiderer by trade. She offers a unique combination of knowledge of both the start-up commercial and home embroidery markets Marie is the author of *Machine Embroidery for Children and Tots* (KP Books, 2007) and co-author of *Machine Embroidered Monograms for the Home* (Designs, 2010).



Debora Jones-My Embroidery Mentor

Deborah Jones is a second generation embroiderer who learned much about embroidery from her father, a tailor who created elaborate embroidered stage costumes for country music performers and rodeo stars. She began using automated embroidery machines that her father imported from Germany in the late 1960s and also learned to create hand-guided embroidery on manual embroidery machines.

In her career, Deborah has managed production in large-scale embroidery shops, operated her own successful embroidery business and served as an editor of a major U.S. embroidery magazine. An author and mentor, she is a popular speaker on embroidery topics. Considered an expert in embroidery for home and commercial machines, Deborah writes the columns "Ask the Expert" and "What to Do When You're New" for Designs in Machine Embroidery magazine and "Technically Speaking" for Stitches magazine.

She is the author of the popular reference book, *Machine Embroidery on Difficult Materials*, and a technique book, *Dimensional Machine Embroidery*. Her expertise covers digitizing, application technique and the business of embroidery. Currently Deborah creates DVD embroidery lessons for home embroiderers on a wide range of embroidery topics.



Barbara Mikolajczyk-Educator

It was obvious at an early age, Barb would sew and teach. She won her 1st sewing award at age 12 while directing theatrical shows in the neighborhood. From New Orleans/Hammond- Take Interstate 10 Westbound to just before Mississippi River Bridge merging onto Interstate 110 North, stay in the far right lane to Exit #1A, Government Street. Turn left onto Government Street heading downtown towards the Mississippi River. Remain in the right lane to the light at St. Louis Street and turn right, paid parking lots will be to your immediate right or left.

From Lafayette/Lake Charles- Take Interstate 10 Eastbound crossing over Mississippi River Bridge, stay in the left lane to Exit #155B merging onto Interstate 110 North. Remain in your left lane to Exit #1B, Convention Street. Follow exit straight onto Convention Street and turn left 2 intersections up onto N. 7th Street/Napoleon. Follow Napoleon to Government Street and turn right. Remain in the right lane to the light at St. Louis Street turning right, paid parking lots will be to your immediate right or left.
